Agreement for Educational
and Scientific Cooperation Between
The University of Oklahoma
and The Universidad Surcolombiana

In order to promote further cooperation between the United States of America and Colombia, The University of Oklahoma and the Universidad Surcolombiana join in the following agreement on educational and scientific cooperation.

The two universities will endeavor to cooperate in educational and research in areas of mutual interest.

To the extent feasible both universities will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty members, departments, and research institutions. The following general forms of cooperation will be pursued:

1. Collaboration of faculty and staff for research, lectures, discussions and other academic pursuits.
2. Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study and research.
3. Exchange of published information.

Themes of joint activities and the conditions for utilizing results achieved and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will be developed mutually for each specific case.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

Hereupon the signatures of the representatives of both universities will follow in the hope of promoting mutual friendship and cooperation. The agreement will remain in effect until one party notifies the other of its wish to terminate the agreement at least ninety (90) days before the end of the academic year.
